Larry Kunz - I bought a Turbo Timber Evolution in July. It comes with floats which I decided I would never use on the plane.... So I made a boat ! It has two methods of steering:

1) the fold up rudders that came with it (rudder channel- left stick)

2) The motor turns side to side (aileron channel - right stick)


The motor can also be adjusted to tilt up or down, since the last boat I made would drive the bow

down on acceleration. I haven't tried it on water yet, but it runs great on wet grass ! (Motor steering only) It turns on a dime, but will flip if turns away too aggressive !

Note: I quickly stripped the gears on the motor turning servo (an old HorizonHobby special)

A Hitec HS-65 was a vast improvement !

I'll report results of on the water tests in the next issue.
