# 2022 Timber Evolution evolution: by Larry Kunz

Usually my plane remodeling's only take a moment of inattention, then hours of fitting and gluing. This one was pre-meditated! I purchased an eflite "Timber Evolution" last spring and have enjoyed flying it,

# BUT:

- 1) The ESC and motor were prone to overheating A five minute flight would leave both too hot to hold a finger on.

  Moving the ESC outside the fuselage, and cutting a large hole in the motor.
- Moving the ESC outside the fuselage, and cutting a large hole in the motor cowling fixed that.
- 2) Long, flimsy control rods for ruder and elevator resulted in iffy response: Moving the servos to the tail with short, rigid control rods should help!
- The included Spektrum A370 servos are junk, and the Aileron linkage is sloppy since it is short coupled so it could be entirely contained within the wing profile
- 4) The ailerons are too small for this 60" wingspan yielding a quite slow roll rate.

  (Yes.. I know it was not billed as a 3D plane!)
- 5) The wings were far from rigid, having only one 1/4" x 1/16" carbon stiffener in a 60 inch wing.
