Case for DX18 transmitter inherited from my nephew by Larry Kunz







This started life as a case for a Porter Cable sander. I never stored the sander in the case, but couldn't quite throw it out. Ten years later, I found out why ! I carved out the inner plastic shell which had custom fit the sander, added some Home Depot rubber floor tile material for padding, and cut a hole for the antenna. The caulking tube holds small tools, bind plug, etc.
