Don Peters November 21, 1922 – April 20, 2022



Donald Peters, former member of Mid-Hudson Modelmasters died April 20, 2022. He was 99 years old. Born November 21, 1922 in Bellmore, Long Island. He was married to the former Anne B. Brunk who pre-deceased him in 2012. Donald served during World War II on the Army Corps of Engineers. He graduated from Farmingdale Community College and owned and operated a Dairy Farm for many years in Chatham, N.Y. and Livingston, N.Y. On Long Island, he worked as a fabricator for Grumman Aircraft and also worked for 12 years as an automobile mechanic. Don was a life-long radio controlled model airplane enthusiast and member of the Sawyer R/C Flyers in Saugerties and Mid-Hudson Modelmasters in Dutchess County. The local flying field in Saugerties was named in his honor. Don as an avid builder who enjoyed designing and building planes. He often used plans he obtained from the Smithsonian Museum. A number of his model planes are on display at the Rhinebeck Aerodrome. Don is survived by his four children and many grand, great and great great grandchildren.
